The agency is certified by the Council on Accreditation and a member of the Alliance for Strong Families and Communities. The model utilized by the Family Treatment Program has been identified as an evidence-based practice by Washington State Institute for Public Policy (WSIPP) and the California Evidence-Based Clearinghouse for Child Welfare. Therapists selected to provide these exciting and innovative services will receive extensive training, and will participate in ongoing quality enhancement activities.
